The regularly scheduled Board Meeting for the Village of Sadorus, was called to order at 7:30 P.M., by President J. Wood. Present were Trustees J. Thompson, D. Deedrick, P. Dubson, J. Deedrick and M. Anliker. Also present was Clerk T. Spence, Treasurer C. Temple and Attorney M. Miller.

P. Dubson motion to approve February minutes as written and read. D. Deedrick second. RCVMC.

J. Deedrick motion to approve warrants to be paid, D. Deedrick second. RCVMC.

P. Dubson motion to accept Treasurer's report as written, J. Thompson second. RCVMC.

J. Deedrick motion to approve Ordinance No. 03-01, an Amended Ordinance Providing for the imposition of simplified municipal telecommunications tax, P. Dubson second. RCVMC.

The Village Clean-up Day will be May 10, 2003 from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. The same items as in the past will be accepted at the clean-up day. Clean-up day is open to the residents of the Village of Sadorus only.

Champaign County Regional Planning Commission suggests the Village wait until Spring 2004 to continue to re-apply for a grant for the playground equipment. J. Deedrick will work on contributions from the public. He will also ask the school district for interest from the children on park ideas.

Sealed mowing bids will be accepted from March 3, 2003 until April 7, 2003. Bids will be opened at the regularly scheduled board meeting on April 7, 2003 at 7:30 p.m. The Village is taking bids for mowing the ballpark, ball diamond, the area by the water plant, the easement by Wilbur Clark's property, and the grass by the "Welcome to Sadorus" sign as you enter Sadorus from the East. For bidding purposes, the Village expects mowers to

mow at an average of 20 times during the mowing season.

There will be a public hearing regarding a variance on the property owned by Dan Lybarger at 401 S. Cider St. on April 7, 2003 at 7:15 p.m. immediately preceding the regularly scheduled board meeting in April

J. Thompson and P. Dubson have spoken with the Adult Softball League. J. Thompson will collect the checkbook from the Skip Spencer and close the account. Attorney M. Miller will draft an agreement between the Village and the Adult Softball League for their use of the park.

Scott Anderson indicates to the Board of the water problem between his property and Seibold's property. He indicates it is a health hazard, especially with the West Nile Virus being prevalent in Illinois. President J. Wood will contact the County Health District on the Anderson's behalf and the Village's behalf to indicate the possible health hazard.

The Village will hold the summer softball and baseball sign-ups for children ages 5-18 on March 22, 2003 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at the Village Hall. All interested parties, please come.
